Application deadline is 5/22/10. Winners must submit required college information to SFLHCC Foundation within 60 days of winning scholarship or will be disqualified from receiving funds. The (5) \$1,000 college scholarships would be provided to graduating Hispanic high school students that are pursuing / have an interest in an insurance career.

In addition, students must have a 2.5 GPA.
